Pennsylvania Educational Tax Credit Programs

- Pennsylvania offers educational tax credits known as the Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) or the Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC).
 - o The EITC program offers the donor a PA tax credit of 90% for a 2 year commitment.
 - Contributions to OSTC provide tuition assistance to eligible students residing within the boundaries of a low-achieving school and allows them to attend another school.
 - A low-achieving school is defined as a school ranking in the bottom 15% based upon combined math and reading scores from the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) tests.
- > Special Purpose Entities (SPE's) are authorized to allow individuals (vs. businesses) to participate in the tax credit programs and gain access to EITC / OSTC tax credits.

Two Ways to Participate!

Businesses

PA businesses can contribute up to \$750,000 to the program. C-Corps, S-Corps, LLCs and Limited Partnerships are eligible to participate.

- > Available to Those Who Do Business in PA
- Receive a 75% Credit for 1-Year
 Commitment or 90% Credit for 2-Years
 New Businesses Can Apply by July 1st
- Designate to a Catholic School of Your Choice

Individuals

Individuals with a tax liability
can now join a Special Purpose Entity
(SPE) to take full advantage of the
PA EITC programs.

What is SPE 2017-18? The SPE 2017-18 program, is a "Special Purpose Entity" (SPE) created by PA to apply for and utilize the EITC/OSTC program. The purpose of the SPE is to be: the vehicle for directing EITC/OSTC funds to families sending their children to our Catholic schools. SPE 2017-18 can provide families with an average tuition assistance of \$1,000. An individual who contributes to SPE 2017-18 can help multiple families across the Archdiocese. SPE Members receive a 90% PA Tax Credit for a Two Year Commitment

- Review your PA-40 Tax Form to understand your current Tax Liability.
 - This amount (on line 12) represents the tax dollars you can redirect to the Foundation for Catholic Education to support SPE 2017-18
 - Please note, certain income does not qualify, such as individual/single income if working for a non-profit.

SPE 2017-18, it just takes a few easy steps!

- The Foundation for Catholic Education submits the SPE 2017-18 application to the State of PA on July 1, 2017.
- 4 The State of PA notifies the SPE 2017-18 of approval in the November 2017 timeframe.
 - $\circ\;$ The Foundation will notify all SPE members of the approval status.
 - If approved, SPE members remit their contributions to the SPE within 30 days.
 - If the SPE is not approved, the SPE members are not required to make the payment, the SPE may apply again the following year.

SPE 2017-18, it just takes a few easy steps!

- In early 2018, SPE members complete their personal PA-40 Tax form and enter their EITC / OSTC tax credit.
 - o The SPE will forward the K-1 Tax Credit to the members
 - The Tax credit is 90% of the SPE member's contribution as approved by the State of PA (2 Year Commitment).
 - o **For example**, a \$1,500 contribution equals a \$1,350 Tax credit (K-1).
 - The Tax credit is a reduction in your PA Tax liability for 2017 (Line 23 of PA 40).






